


Geographic Information Systems (GIS)

- GIS uses computer programs to collect, store, analyze, and share geographic data
- Geospatial Technologies allow users to view relationships and identify patterns more easily with different layers
- GIS Example



Remote Sensing

- Using images taken remotely to collect and analyze spatial information
- Images primarily taken by Airplanes, Satellites, and Drones



Global Positioning Systems (GPS)

- Network of interlinked satellites (24) working with ground reference stations to communicate location
- Used for precising location services and navigation
